



## Website Privacy Policy

### Overview

The Balwyn Blazers Basketball Club (Blazers) follows the policies and directions of Basketball Victoria, see <http://basketballvictoria.com.au/policies/>

The personal information we collect is to assist us better communicate to the players, teams and coaches. We do not hand over your information to third parties unless it is with your consent. Unless parents / players submit in writing to the Club Administrator, the Club will assume that is acceptable and you agree to:

- Distribution amongst team members of your phone number, or e-mail addresses
- Being photographed or videoed during training sessions or games.

### Privacy Policy

The Balwyn Blazers Basketball Club (Blazers) appreciates the importance of protecting your personal information and recognise the trust placed in us when you supply your personal information to us. Blazers will control the collection, security, quality, use and disclosure of personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth).

This Privacy Policy explains in general terms how Blazers protects the privacy of your personal information under the National Privacy Principles. It will apply to any personal information you provide to us when registering to our services and / or enquiring about our services.

At Blazers we respect your right to privacy. We understand that as a visitor to our website, you prefer to control your own personal information preferences. For this reason, we may ask you to register or provide personal information and preferences when you visit certain areas of our website, request information, register for events, fill out an enquiry form or subscribe to our company newsletters. When you provide Blazers with your name, email address, mailing address, or telephone number, we may use this information to alert you to company news, new services and other company and product information.

### Collection of your Personal Information

Blazers collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Blazers also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your postcode, age, gender, preferences, interests and favourites. There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Blazers. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used by Blazers for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Blazers website. Please bear in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Blazers's public message boards or social media outlets, this information may be collected and used by others.

### Use of your Personal Information

Blazers collects and uses your personal information to operate the Blazers's website and deliver the services you have requested. Blazers also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Blazers and its affiliates. Blazers may also contact you via surveys to conduct research



about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered. Blazers does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Blazers may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Blazers may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Blazers, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information. Blazers does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Blazers keeps track of the websites and pages our customers visit within Blazers, in order to determine what Blazers services are the most popular. Blazers will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Blazers or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Blazers; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Blazers, or the public.

## Use of Cookies

The Blazers website uses “cookies” to help you personalize your on-line experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Blazers pages, or register with Blazers or services, a cookie helps Blazers with the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Blazers website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Blazers features that you customized. You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Blazers’s services or websites you visit. For the security of your personal information Blazers secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. Blazers secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other website, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

**How we Protect your Personal Information:** Blazers will try to protect the personal information that you share with us. Blazers stores information in a controlled, secure environment. At no point will Blazers disclose any of your personal information to any third parties. All credit card/payment details are secured protocol (Secured Socket Layer over 128bit encryption).

**How to Update your Personal Information:** You can help Blazers maintain the accuracy of your personal information by notifying us when you change your name, address, title, phone number, e-mail address or your content preferences. If at any time you wish to update your information or preferences, or you prefer to stop receiving communication from Blazers, feel free to contact us at any time or change your details in the members section of the Blazers website.
